The situation will be reviewed at the next committee meeting of the GSTTA, scheduled for Tuesday 31 March 2020, provided that TTSA or TTA have provided us with further information or recommendations. "

We hope we can resume playing table tennis in the not-too-distant future. Our vibrant and successful association deserves this.
