CAPTAINS : The highest ranked team listed player shall be the team captain unless otherwise determined by the team. The captain shall be responsible to ensure the satisfactory completion of score-sheets, sharing of umpiring & to ensure timely completion of team matches. **Captains** please share tables near the end of team matches to achieve a coordinated finish prior to supper.

SUPPER, DISHWASHING & TABLE DUTIES

PLAYERS in the two teams listed on the duty roster shown on the program for each night are to supply supper, help get the hall ready & clean up after the night. Players in rostered teams please arrive by 7.15 to prepare for play to commence at 7.30 **All players** please wait for all matches to be completed before starting supper. Tea, coffee, sugar etc. supplied by GSTTA

PLAYERS please note: Do not take food/drinks (except water bottles) into playing/spectator area.

PLAYERS please share umpiring & assist new players with umpiring & rules.

COMPETITION NOTES

- **Matches** are to be played under the official rules of table tennis. Players are programmed to play two singles & two doubles rubbers, with a total of 12 singles & 6 doubles rubbers in each team match. Singles & doubles rubbers to be best of five advantage sets to 11 points.
- **Pre-rubber warm-ups** to be restricted to a maximum of 2 minutes.
- **Teams** are allocated tables 1 & 2 or 4 & 5 as shown on the program, with table 3 being shared.
- **PREMIERSHIP POINTS** are allocated as follows :
 - 5 points** for a 10-8 win or better
 - 4 points** for a 9-9 result & a win on sets
 - 3 points** for a 9-9 draw with equal sets
 - 2 points** for a 9-9 result & a loss on sets
 - 1 point** for a 8-10 or worse loss

Premiership awarded to team with most premiership points after last match. **No finals**
