COMPETITION NOTES:

Matches: to be played under the official rules of table tennis.

Please focus on legal serving.

Players programmed to play two singles and two doubles rubbers each.

Singles to be best of five , Doubles best of Three advantage games to 11 points.

Matches to commence with number 5 and 6 singles. Doubles combinations are first round 4&6, 2&5,1&3, second round 5&6, 3&4, 1&2.

2 minute warm up before each rubber.

Please wear plain contrasting colour to white ball.

Tables are allocated as per program, tables 2 and 4 to be shared by all teams table 5 closest to stage.

Each team to nominate a captain to be responsible for filling out names on the score sheet and ensuring results are entered correctly. Score sheets to be signed by both captains at end of night, Captains to make sure flow of rubbers is continuous.

The aim is to try and finish all matches around the same time.

All players to share umpiring. New players to be assisted with umpiring and rules.

Only change umpires at end of a set, not during set.

Premiership ladder will be on GSTTA.org.au, and on notice board.

Pick balls up by hand, do not wipe hands on tables

SUPPER & TABLE DUTIES (refer to roster on the match programme)

Duties: provide and serve supper, prepare the hall for match play, wash dishes, and ensure hall is clean before closing.

All tables to be taken down at the end of play on the second, fourth and fifth Mondays of the month. All players from teams that are rostered on, are asked to share these responsibilities. Please wait for all teams to complete their matches before starting supper. Tea, coffee, milk, sugar etc. provided by GSTTA.

Drink bottles only in main playing hall.
